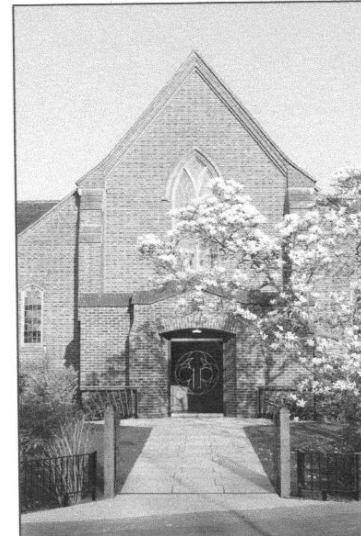

We have been advised by our architect, David Loxton, that if there are a large number of members of the public there supporting a particular planning application it places greater pressure on the committee members to vote in support of the application.
