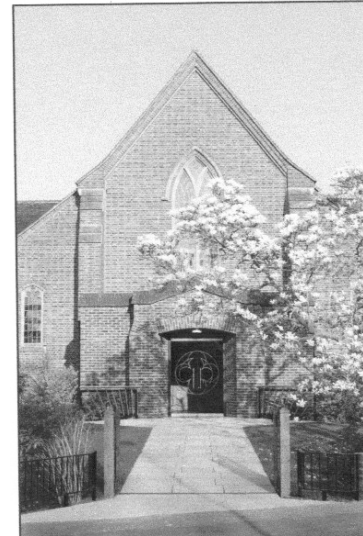

A Message from the Vicar

Dear Friends,

Being a Vicar, tends to be an all-consuming life, and since ordination I have never been away from the Parish for more than two weeks. So after nearly a decade and a half in full-time ordained ministry I head-off on Sabbatical.
