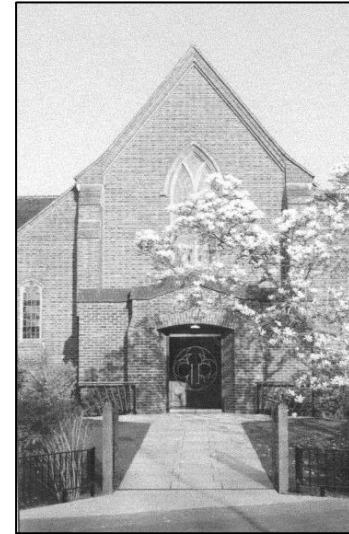

Lent Appeal 2019

Instead of joining in the Diocese of London's Lent Appeal the PCC have decided to lend our support to 'Project Grow' a special appeal being made on behalf of our neighbouring parish of St Richard's Hanworth – an urban priority area with high levels of social deprivation. Sadly, over the years, thieves have stripped all the copper from the roof forcing the church to use roofing felt (similar to that used on garden sheds), to keep the rain out. The church has exciting plans for its future development but desperately needs to restore the badly leaking roof as a first step if it is to survive.

The Revd Dr Craig Holmes, Vicar of St Richard's, will be coming to preach at our 8am and 10am Sunday services on 24 March to explain more about the importance of this project and the difference your gifts will make. Please consider supporting this generously as part of your giving for Lent.
